- Support the sourcing team with purchasing fuel

You are free to apply to several Monjasa locations, but please submit only one application. You will be able to select your preferred locations in the application form. You will also be asked to upload a short video introduction of yourself. We will guide you through every step of the process.

After the application deadline, we will invite the candidates with the best fit for a personal interview on 22/23 April 2026. If you have shown interest in more than one location, you will be invited to the event closest to your home.
